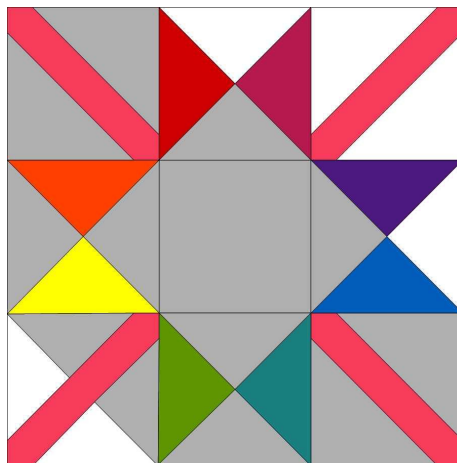



# Star Daze: Block 8


Unfinished block should measure 9.5"  
(It will be 9" once it is sewn into the quilt)





## Cutting Instructions


- From 8 fat quarters (all colors **except pink**), cut one 4.5" square, then cut once diagonally to make two triangles.
- From the pink fat quarter, cut out four (4) 4" squares.
- From the color background, cut out (1) 3.5" square, (2) 4" squares, and (3) 4.5" squares. Cut the 4" and the 4.5" squares once diagonally to make two triangles.
- From the white background, cut out (1) 4" square, and (2) 4.5" squares. Cut the 4" and the 4.5" squares once diagonally to make two triangles.


 Red: (1) - 4.5" square


 Teal: (1) - 4.5" square


 Orange: (1) - 4.5" square


 Blue: (1) - 4.5" square


 Yellow: (1) - 4.5" square


 Purple: (1) - 4.5" square

 Green: (1) - 4.5" square

 Raspberry: (1) - 4.5" square

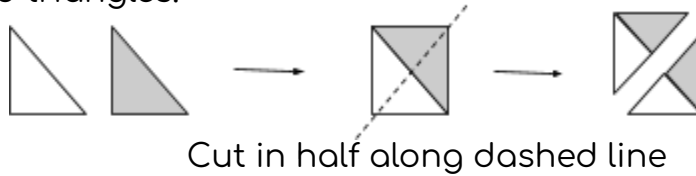
 Color bg: (1) - 3.5" square  
(2) - 4" square  
(3) - 4.5" square

 White bg: (1) - 4" square  
(2) - 4.5" square

 Pink: (4) - 4" square

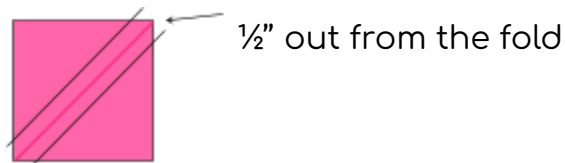
## Assembly

- Take (1) 4.5" color background triangle and put it with (1) 4.5" white background triangle; sew together on the longest side to make one half square triangle. Cut diagonally in half along the dotted line to make two triangles.

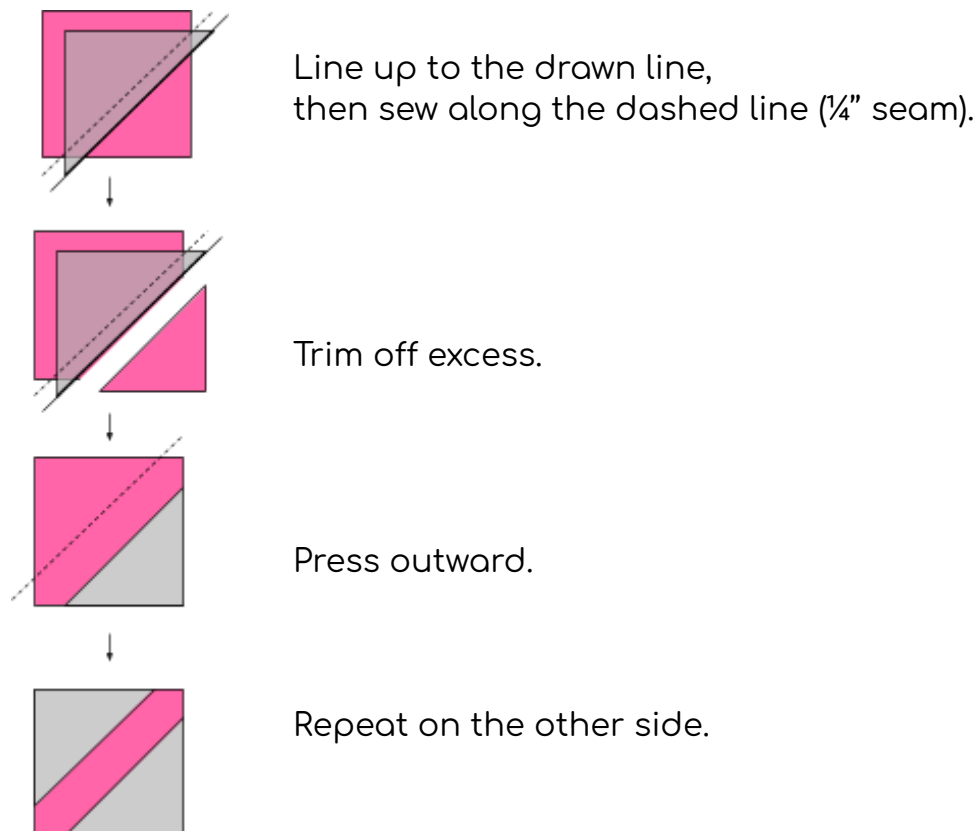


Cut in half along dashed line

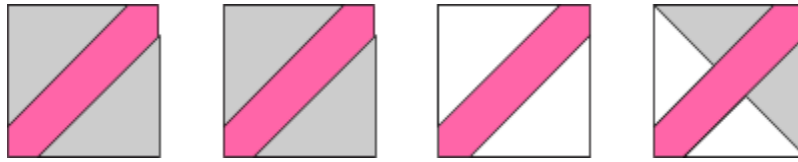
- Take the (4) 4" pink squares, fold diagonally and press. Open the squares back up, and draw two lines, a half inch on either side of the center fold.



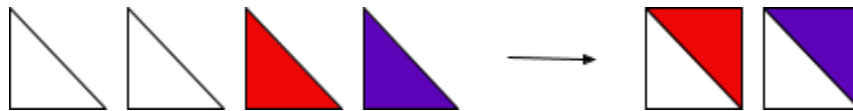
- Take one of the color by 4" triangles and line the long edge up with one of the drawn lines as shown below. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam along that edge. Trim the excess of the pink square off, then press out.



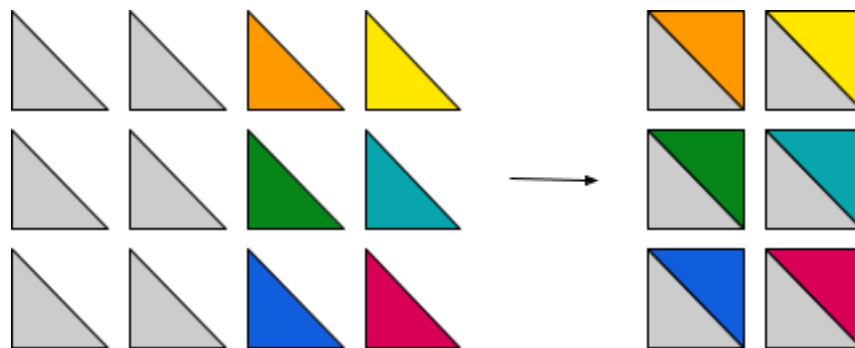
- Repeat the prior step 3 more times to make a total of four pink pieces as shown below. (Be careful to orient the HST the correct way!)



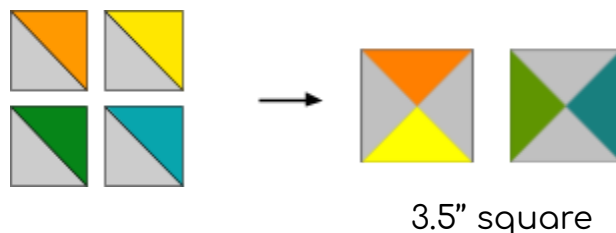
- Pair a 4.5" white background triangle with one of the 4.5" triangles of each of the following colors: red and purple. Sew together to make half square triangles.



- Pair a 4.5" color background triangle with one of the 4.5" triangles of each of the remaining colors: orange, yellow, green, teal, blue, and raspberry. Sew together to make half square triangles.

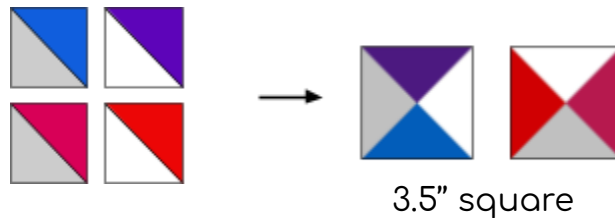


- Take the green HST and pair with the teal HST. Sew them together to create a green/teal/color bg quarter square triangle. Press open. Trim to 3.5" square. Repeat with the orange and yellow HSTs to make one more orange and yellow quarter square triangle.

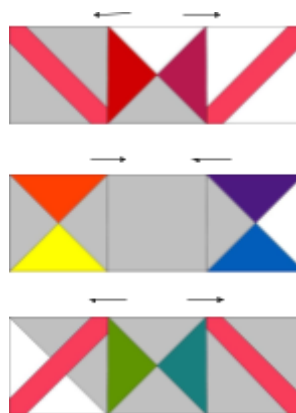


3.5" square

- Take the blue HST and pair with the purple and white HST. Sew them together to create a quarter square triangle. Press open. Trim to 3.5" square. Repeat with the red and white HST and the raspberry and color background HST to make another quarter square triangle. Trim to 3.5" square.



- Arrange the blocks in 3 rows as shown in the diagram below. Sew together, pressing in direction of the arrows.



- Sew the rows together to form the block. The block should measure 9.5".
